The afternoon meeting in the Tabernacle on Sunday will go down as one of the most important happenings in the town's history, namely the division of Cardston into two wards.

Up to the present time Cardston has comprised one ward under the one bishop and two counsellors but owing to the rapid increase in population it has been found impossible for a continuance of conditions, as it is now out of the question for a district of such a large area and so heavily peopled to be attended to by an organization of three. The only solution offered was the creating of a new ward and this as stated above was brought to a head at the Ward Conference on Sunday afternoon.

The new ward will be known as the Second Ward and will comprise the district lying east of 2nd
